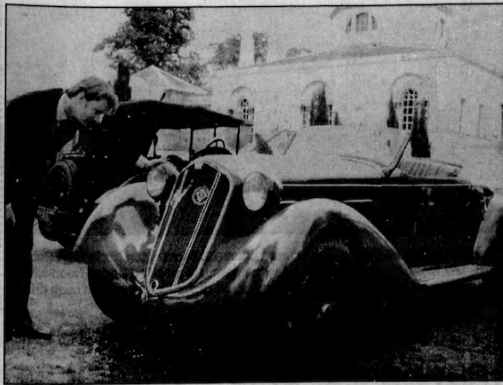

Automakers battle gas additive

TORONTO (CP) — The auto industry and the makers of a gasoline additive have taken their dispute public, putting ads in newspapers to influence the federal government's plan to ban MMT.

First it was Ethyl Canada Corp., which two weeks ago bought pages in three papers making the argument there was no reason to remove the octane enhancer — and that in fact the environment might suffer if MMT disappeared.

Last week, 18 carmakers and auto importers banded together to put an ad in the Toronto Globe and Mail saying "MMT has to go," in response to the Ethyl ad, industry spokesman Mark Nantais said.

The carmakers reiterated their position that MMT clogs computer sensors that warn drivers when their pollution-control systems are failing.

The ad campaigns come as the government's bill to ban the import of MMT is near being introduced in Parliament. Environment Minister Sheila Copps is moving "as quickly as she can," spokesman Duncan Dee said.

Despite the protests from Ethyl, "we've got evidence from the automakers" that points to the problems caused by MMT, Dee said. Ethyl president David Wilson said the minister had another agenda in moving to ban MMT. She wants to adopt U.S. rules, which kept the additive out of U.S. gasoline for 18 years, he said.

Ethyl's U.S. parent company recently won a court challenge that will see MMT back in use by year-end, Wilson said.

As well as buying ads, both parties have been contacting members of Parliament, cabinet ministers and government committees.

Ford to offer V-8 Explorer

The sport-utility segment in Canada has levelled out at about 13 per cent of the market but sales at the upper end are still brisk — witness Land Rover's success with its \$40,000-plus Discovery.

Even Toyota Canada has turned a blind eye to importation of Canadianized examples of the U.S.-destined Land Cruisers by dealers at upwards of \$50,000.

So it's no surprise that Ford of Canada is rushing a V-8 powered version of its popular Explorer sport-ute to market.

Ford says its five-litre V-8, a version of which also powers the Mustang GT, will be offered in 1996 models of the two-wheel-drive Explorer XLT much earlier than originally planned.

Buyers now will have the choice of the existing four-litre V-6 or the more powerful eight-cylinder.

Prices were not announced. "This decision will allow customers seeking more horsepower and towing capacity to purchase an Explorer," said John Radford, Ford's vice-president of general sales.

Domestic competitor Jeep offers its Grand Cherokee with an optional V-8, and General Motors' comparable Chevy Blazer and GMC Jimmy models come with more powerful sixes.

GM also introduced larger, V-8 powered Tahoe and Yukon models for 1995. Land Rover's Discovery and Range Rover models also come with V-8s.

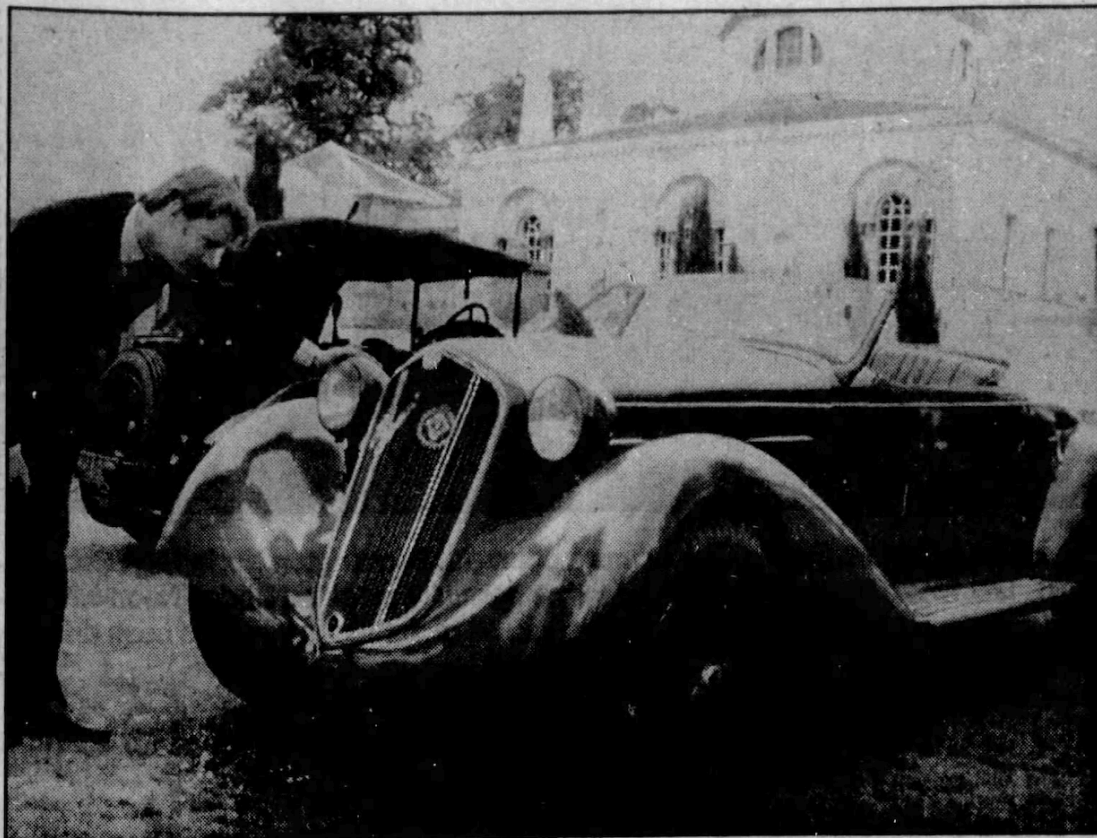
