

The Graduate

Thanks to Craig Morningstar, I had the use of a Graduate for a week. It was bright red with a natural leather-looking interior which, in fact, was vinyl, one of the "deletes" which makes the Graduate the most affordable Alfa.

Enthusiasts have been asking for a "stripper" Alfa for some time. You know — take off all the heavy accessories and just give us the bare-bones car with no frills. Well, that's what the Graduate is.

The thing which most impressed me about the car is that, if you didn't tell anyone, they probably wouldn't notice the differences. American manufacturers make you suffer if you insist on buying a "stripper." (I remember the first Chevette, where you had to pay extra for a back seat in the lowest-priced model. It kept you humble with crummy door-pull straps and an ill-fitting fiberboard interior.) The Graduate has everything the enthusiast needs and nothing to detract from the sheer excitement of the basic car. Plenty of carpeting, super seats, full instrumentation and the very same engine that makes the others go, including a revised variableintake camshaft which now ties in with the Bosch fuel injection black box.

At about \$13,500, the Graduate has to

be the best convertible buy on the market. In the first place, it's a true convertible, not the "chop-top" conversions other manufacturers offer. As a result, the top is not a compromise: It doesn't intrude on interior room and seals perfectly. I drove the Graduate in rain and found it to be watertight and very secure. It doesn't flap around at speed, either.

The Graduate owner gives up the alloy wheels, air conditioning, power windows and sideview mirrors, radio and leather interior of the Spider Veloce. What's left is a most respectable car which loses nothing of its Alfa essence: The steel wheels have additional chrome rings to keep the exterior flashy and they connect at the rearto a limited-slip differential. The passenger side rearview mirror is convex to help
