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42th Rally Sanremo Rallye d'Italia 2000

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Peugeot's second 1-2 win in a row marks them as very serious contenders for this year's world rally championship. Apart from the first stage when Richard Burns' Subaru was marginally ahead, the 206 WRCs led Sanremo Rally all the way. Burns tried hard to keep up but a driving error damaged the cooling system and he retired on the second day. Despite his injuries in Corsica, Colin McRae recovered sufficiently to take the start and finished sixth overall, but the Fords were off the pace. Only two fastest times by guest driver Piero Liatti eased the disappointment. The only driver to split the three car Peugeot team was the Mitsubishi of Tommi Makinen. This was another event where accidents were frequent but the main challenge was on the organisers who had introduced a new format for the event. Aimed at preventing chaos on the surrounding public roads, the rally used the same stages at frequent intervals. The system worked well until the final day, Sunday, when excessive crowds caused both planned stages to be abandoned.

The top four drivers are now separated by only six points and Peugeot, Ford and Subaru can all easily win the Makes' championship. Three of the Teams' Cup entries can still become champion, with only two events now left to run. Ironically despite the best results for Mitsubishi since May their hopes of the Manufacturers' title have now ended, and ironical that despite Abdullah Bakhshab's top placing in the Teams' Cup, the Toyota Mobil Saudi Arabia team have also now abandoned their hopes having competed on the allowed number of events.

This was the final all-asphalt event in the 2000 season, and Subaru were still confident their recent poor results could bring them success, with Burns having won the last two rounds in last year's championship. An amazingly strong entry came to Sanremo. Peugeot, Ford and Subaru all had three works entries and all seven registered teams were present. No fewer than 39 World Rally Cars took the start. Coming shortly after Corsica left little time for engineers to plan any technical novelties, but the unregistered Toyota team introduced new gearshift and rear subframes for their private drivers.

As the organisers held their breath the rally began on time and safely. The roads were damp with the morning humidity and the drama was when Francois Delecour lost around 12 seconds on the opening stages with a failed fresh-air (anti-lag) system. This was a gap he could never catch back on his teammate Gilles Panizzi and haunted him as he strove for the chance to avenge the Corsica team-order defeat. Notable in the early stages was the performance of Piero Longhi with his Italian championship winning Toyota, fitted with the new Toyota rear suspension. He was holding fourth place before brushing against a guard rail which then gave way. Makinen was unhappy with his car on the first day and was fighting with Marcus Gronholm for sixth place.

On the second day Makinen made his attack and rose from seventh place to third in three stages. It was a masterful performance by the world champion, who started the day tragically. He and his trainer were jogging in the town when his colleague was badly hurt by a police motorcyclist who died in the crash. Burns was lying third when he made his error. Water escaped from the engine which failed as he drove into the Service Park in Sanremo. This momentarily let Sainz into third place behind the two Peugeots but it was the highest a Ford got on this event, before Sainz was passed by first Makinen and then Gronholm.

The third day was disastrous. Required by the FIA to run stages on a Sunday, the organisers found the crowds were uncontrollable. Markko Martin slid off the road and hit two spectators, causing the first stage to be interrupted, then after five cars passed on the second, the safety officials ordered this to be stopped as well. There were other disasters! SEAT were never even in the top ten positions. Didier Auriol had a spark plug fail, then had power steering failure and the engine blew out quantities of oil. Toni Gardemeister had handling trouble, his car went on to three cylinders and then his turbo failed.

Skoda were bemused. They saw themselves further from the top than before - but their times were now much closer! Such was the intensity of the competition ahead. Schwarz had a differential problem which affected the braking, Climent had the exhaust manifold loosen which affected the turbo pressure and let fumes inside the car. Not such a good rally for Hyundai. Alister McRae suffered a lot of hydraulic problems and Kenneth Eriksson lost considerable time on a stage with fuel pressure failure.

In Group N the former Ford works driver Alex Fiorio took advantage of his poor starting number and drove well on roads which were drier than for those running earlier. Chasing him hard was Gianluigi Galli in another Mitsubishi, Group N winner here on the last two Sanremo's, who was slowed by a damaged rear suspension and then spun. Fiorio held on to the lead but on the second day was delayed by loss of power, and Galli went on to gain his hat-trick. Behind, there was a battle between the two championship leaders Manfred Stohl and Gustavo Trelles. Trelles had an engine failure in Shakedown and on the event damaged the rear suspension but caught up with Stohl and beat him by just 3.4 seconds at the finish. They were among the majority of competitors who were denied any competitive rallying on the final day. Both Claudio Menzi and Gabriel Pozzo slid off the road but the Peruvian Ramon Ferreyros was fifth.

Renato Travalia won every stage in the F2 category and was completely unchallenged. More interesting was the 1600cc category. Leading in the beginning again was Patrick Magaud's Ford Puma but he was delayed by a driveshaft failure. He fell to third place but then the electrics failed and he was out. Luca Cantamessa took over the lead in this class with a Fiat Punto KC but then fellow Fiat driver Luca Pedersoli, who had earlier been de-layed by a puncture, caught up and took the lead. The Teams' Cup had four entries. Frederic Dor who was now out of the series stayed away to pursue his French gravel championship challenge. Hamed Al Wahaibi, slid on a damp patch on the opening stage, hit a wall the engine stalled and would not restart. This left just Abdullah Bakhshab and Serkan Yazici. Bakhshab ran very late after damaging his suspensions (last minute before being excluded) and finished well behind Yazici.

Peugeot never expected to be leading both major World series and know that they face unwelcome odds on the next two event. There was, however, a lot more to the business of Peugeot's double-double win. Deep behind the smiling faces on the podiums were tensions which the team worked hard to dispel but were emerging none the less. For their pair of French drivers the battle for supremacy, and the background behind their apparently un-happy struggles to win, is based more on wanting a contract next year than actually wanting to win this year!
