

Ferrari's LMH opened its eyes for the first time at Imola

Ferrari continues to test its LMH (Le Mans Hypercar) prototype, which will compete next year in the WEC and, for the first time in 50 years, the 24 Hours of Le Mans. After completing the first test at Fiorano early last month, Ferrari's LMH is back in action at Imola for another test session, showing its headlights for the first time.



Although camouflaged, we get to see its headlights for the first time positioned in the lower part of the hood, near the sides of the central air intake, complemented by horizontal thin light strips at the front reminiscent of the Daytona SP3's style.
