

Michelin has claimed 20 victories at Sebring (12 Hours + 1000 Miles).



"A new era is here with the Hypercar class having the legendary names of Porsche, Toyota, Peugeot, Glickenhaus and Cadillac all battling for overall honors at the start of the new FIA WEC season."

"It is a great time for us all - the teams, manufacturers, drivers and especially the fans. Well, we are actually all fans in the Sportscar paddock."

"I know this new category will give us some great racing, by pushing the manufacturers, teams and drivers to the absolute limit searching for new ways to go faster for longer, to find new solutions and break new ground with new technologies, with one objective...to win the race."

"The track is bumpy with different surfaces ranging from asphalt to concrete with some corners a patchwork of both, add in Floridian sun baking the surface to over 40°C, it creates a tough track which is a real test for the driver, car and tires. A tire has to withstand incredible abuse at Sebring, changing surfaces from concrete to

asphalt, searing Floridian heat, sand and debris."

"My father Bert always reminded me, "to finish first, first you have to finish", so in Sebring you first of all need a reliable car, and I also mean one you can trust over the difficult bumps and track surfaces, as well as not changing too much in feel over the race distance. A tire that

gives good, consistent grip and feedback to the driver over multiple stints; a trained, sharp pit stop crew that performs under pressure; a good physio to repair the driver's body after a long stint behind the wheel; and good strategic agility to take into account everything Sebring will throw at you over the race distance."

"I won my four Sebring 12 Hours including the first-ever FIA WEC race at Sebring in 2012 with Michelins on my Audi. They gave me the confidence to push to the limit in the most extreme test in Sportscar racing, but that made the late night podium celebrations even more memorable."

"The circuit at Sebring uses a former US Army airfield and features a mix of different surface types, from concrete, to old and - in places recent asphalt. The switches between the concrete slabs make this track very bumpy, but it is also very fast, and that makes car set-up a complex job. Our partners in the hypercar class have a new range of MICHELIN Pilot Sport Slicks, featuring new compounds, and

their rain tires have a new pattern. The two Prologue test days gave us a chance to evaluate our 2023 range as the LMDh prototypes join the hypercar runners. The challenge for our technical advisors has been to examine our two compound options carefully after use in order to pinpoint their respective operating windows car by car in readiness for the 1000 Miles of Sebring."

Soft hot: for average-wearing or 'rubbered' track surfaces, temperatures in excess of 15°C (core range tyre).

Medium: abrasive track surfaces, demanding track configurations, temperatures in excess of 30°C.

SEBRING



The population of Sebring (Highlands County, Florida) is around 10,000

Sebring was founded in 1912 by pottery-maker George E. Sebring who discovered the location on a fishing

The venue was formerly a US Army airfield during World War 2

In 1950, the first-ever race at Sebring was won by a spectator's car!

Sebring hosted Formula 1's USA Grand Prix in 1959 (winner: Bruce McLaren)

Many of the streets in one of Sebring's districts have racing-related names

The name Sebring has been given to numerous car models, including the **Chrysler Sebring**

Sebring winners traditionally celebrate with orange juice

MICHELIN AND SEBRING



- In 1999, Michelin won the first 12 Hours of Sebring race to count towards the American Le Mans Series
- In 2012, Michelin won the first 12 Hours

- of Sebring to count towards the FIA World Endurance Championship
- Michelin holds the lap record for Sebring with Fernando Alonso (Toyota TS050 Hybrid): 1m40.124s (average speed: 216.4kph)
- · Michelin has won the 12 Hours of Sebring a record six times with Tom Kristensen
- Michelin was inducted into Sebring's Hall of Fame in 2010
- The Michelin Bridge straddles Turn 17

MICHELIN AND AMERICAN ENDURANCE RACING



- Michelin totaled 143 race wins and 28 titles in the American Le Mans Series from 1999 until 2013
- In 2019. Michelin became the Official Tire of the IMSA WeatherTech SportsCar Championship
- Michelin has won every one of the six 6 Hours of Circuit of the Americas at Austin, Texas, that have counted towards the FIA WEC
- In January, Michelin and Acura scored a 1-2 finish in the new GTP category at the 24 Hours of Daytona

ENDURANCE RACING: AN ACCELERATOR OF INNOVATION FOR MICHELIN

Michelin has long used motorsport in general, and endurance racing and Le Mans in particular, as a means to accelerate the development of its innovations. The 1923 Le

Mans 24 Hours is a perfect example!

It was 100 years ago this year that the Chenard & Walcker Sports of René Lagache/André Léonard and Raoul Bachmann/Christian Dauvergne came first and second in the inaugural Le Mans 24 Hours on Michelin tires.

The sport's first 24-hour race took place around a 17-kilometer, dirt



and asphalt loop that was strewn with stones and made muddy by rain and hailstones. Michelin's answer for the conditions was the revolutionary Confort,

an innovative tire that was capable of running at a low pressure (2.5 bar) over a distance of 15,000km. Its technology helped the N°9 Chenard & Walcker Sport take the win after completing 2,209km at an average speed of 92kph. Buoyed by its success at Le Mans, the Michelin Confort was a big hit with the motoring public of the day!



FIA WEC TIRE REGULATIONS

Michelin has been appointed as the exclusive tire supplier for the FIA WEC's Hypercar prototypes.

Teams competing in LMGTE Am may work with the tire manufacturer of their choice. Michelin has been nominated by all the competitors in this class.

SLICKS

Hypercars:

Three types of slick for the season for all of the cars, with two types of slick to be nominated 48 hours before the Prologue test. Two types of slick to be nominated 48 hours at the latest before the start of scrutineering (three types for Le Mans).

- Tire manufacturers must draw up identical usage indications (tire pressures, camber) for all competitors.
 Non-compliance with these indications will result in the competitor being reported to the Sporting Stewards.
- In the case of 29/34 tires, tires will be allocated to each competitor at meetings by a random process carried out by the Technical Delegates. These tires to count for the Qualifying + Race allocation. Procedure established by the WEC Committee.
- In the case of 31/31 tires, a procedure to collect and redistribute tires established by the WEC Committee.
- The WEC Committee may make changes to the random tire allocation and/or tire collection/redistribution procedures at any point in the season.

LM GTE Am:

Only those tire specifications nominated for the 2022 championship may be used in 2023

All the specifications for the season must be declared to the Technical Delegate before the start of the season.

Three types of slick for the season for all of the cars. Two types of slick for each race (three types for Le Mans).

RAIN TIRES

Rain tires may only be used if Race Control declares the track to be wet (Free Practice, Qualifying, Race). No per-event quotas.

LM GTE Am: One type of rain tire and one type of intermediate tire per model entered 48 hours prior to the Prologue. The re-cutting of tread patterns is not authorized.

Altering the property of a tire by either chemical or mechanical means is not permitted, except for the removal of debris picked up on the track.

The tires' (fil ou) profile may not be modified or re-cut.

Processes involving a direct or indirect test aimed at modifying the temperature of a tire (in relation to ambient temperature) are not permitted.

In the course of the season, a competitor may change tire supplier no more than once.

Infringement of the tire allowance: Stop & Go of 2 minutes per tire.

Breach of tire-warming rules: three-minute Stop&Go during the race.

A maximum of four mechanics and two tire guns for wheel changes during pit stops. Tire changes are not authorized while the car is being refueled.

1 tire technician authorized to check tire temperatures and pressures.

Tire changes are only authorized a) on the grid up to the five-minute board, b) in front of the car's garage during a pit stop or inside the garage if more extensive work on the car is required, or c) on the track if the race is suspended.

Tires are identified by RFID chips and bar codes. All tire serial numbers must be provided to the Technical Delegates 48 hours in advance.
