A new and highly touted track has risen at Hourglass Field, U.S. Navy property just 12 miles north of San Diego. The 1.7 mile, eight-turn circuit as a main straight 2,000 feet long, and drivers rate it as top-notch. Entries include: Axel Wars and Jerge Rosado, both from Mexico City.
