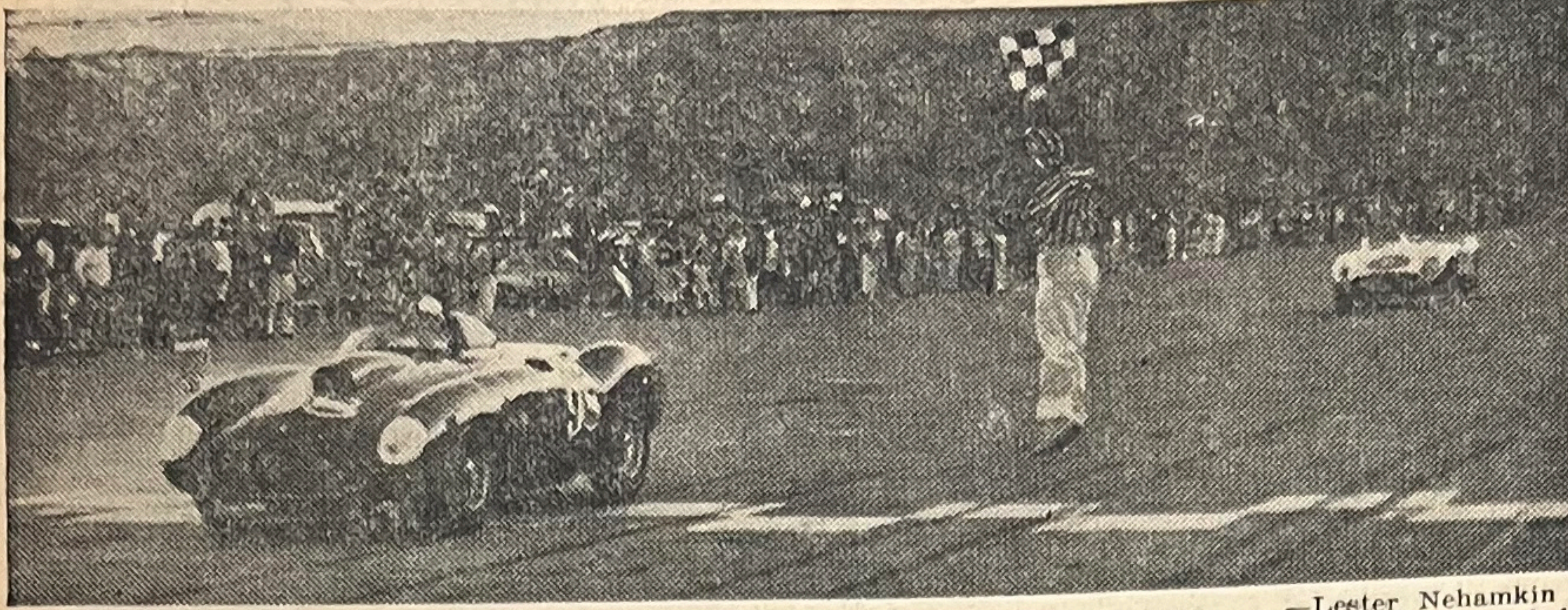


Winners at Palm Springs National Races

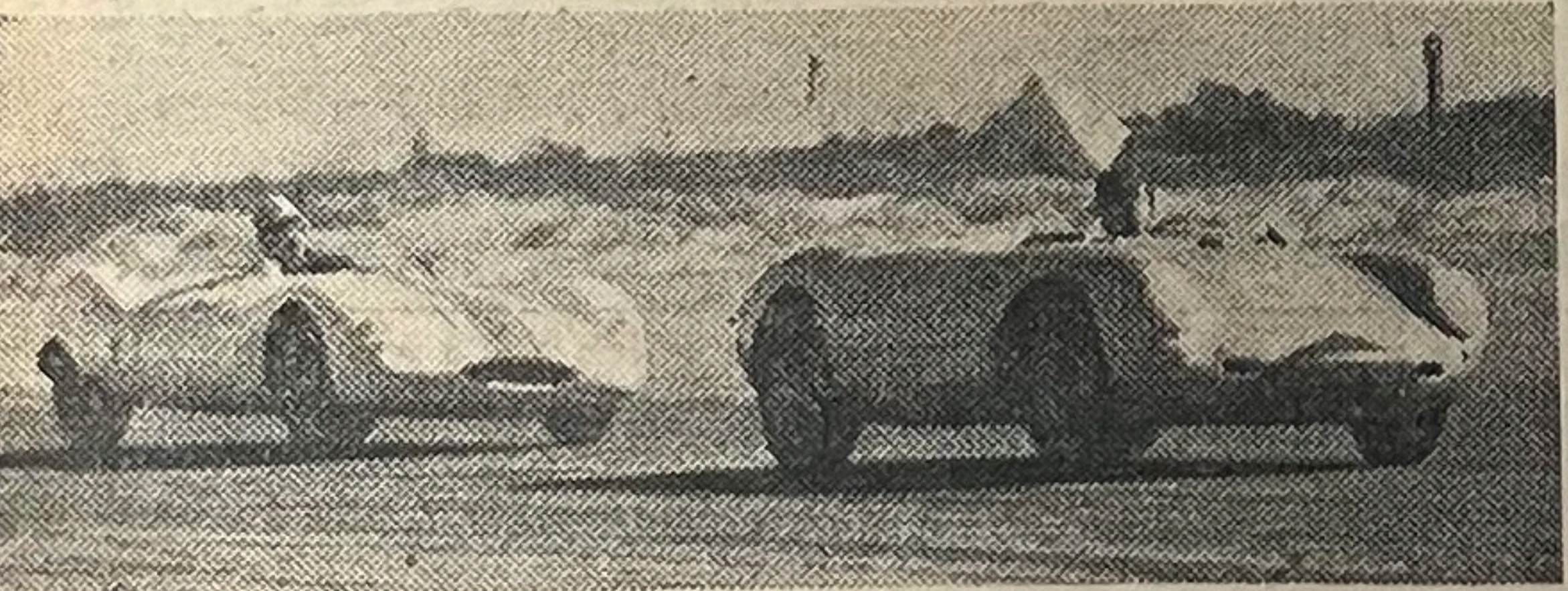

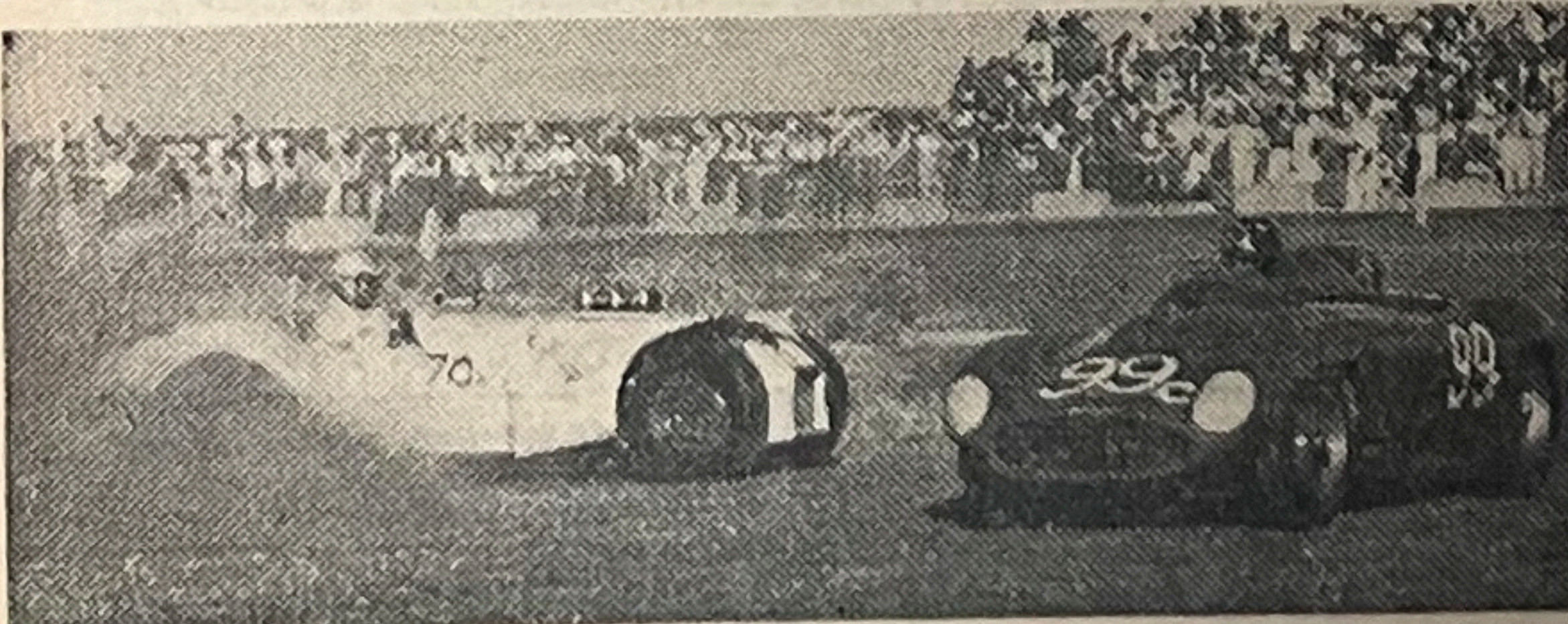
