CLASS AWARDS WILL BE MADE IN ALL RACES EXCEPT 9. OVERALL AWARDS WILL BE MADE IN RACES 8, 10, 11, 12 and 13.

AWARDS TO FIRST 3 PLACES MODIFIED & PRODUCTION OVER AND UNDER 1500cc IN RACE 9. If less than three cars start, the car will move up one class.

If three cars in one class start, one award will be made. If four start, two and if five start, three awards.

Classes—Supercharged cars will run in the next larger class.

Class A—8000cc and over

Class B—5000cc-8000cc

Class C—3000cc-5000cc

Class D—2000cc-3000cc

Class E—1500cc-2000cc

Class F—1100cc-1500cc

Class G—750cc-1100cc

Class H—500cc-750cc
