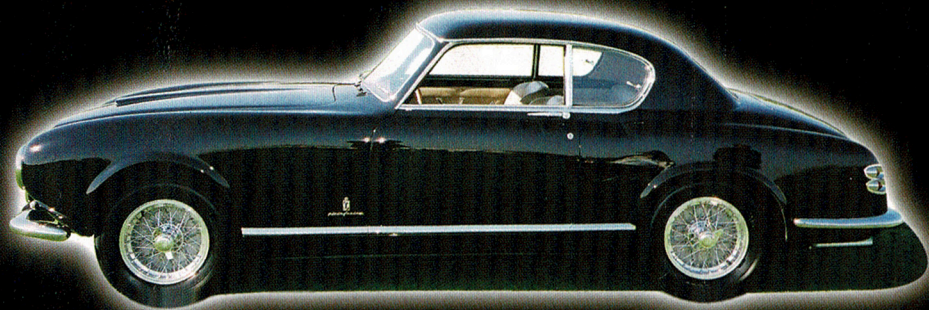
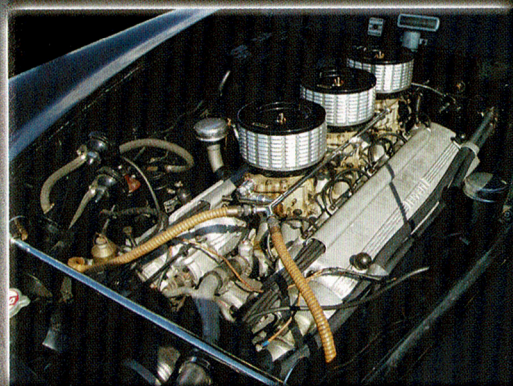


1953 Ferrari 342 America One-Off Pinin Farina "Speciale"
