Dear Nigel,

Your Riley 9 Sports is a "Brooklands" prototype model, that was firstly registered by Mr. Percy Riley on 20.07.1928 with the original chassis # 6019 and plate WK 6652.

As You may know, all the cars registered in the thirties with WK prefix were "ex-works" car built by Thomson & Taylor for the racing purposes of the Riley Engine Company.

This peculiar item was personally driven by Mr. Percy Riley in the 1928 and 1929 Tourist Trophies, so the engine # should be 40100 and the body has to be black on green chassis.

Our suggestion is to restore it with the period specifications, which You can see on :

- page 79 and page 83 of A.T Birmigham's book " The production and competition history of the pre-1939 Riley Motor Cars";
- page 189 and page 190 of D.G. Styles' book " As old as the Industry".
