

A. J. Foyt, the Indianapolis 500 veteran, was second with 112.799 clocking in Scarab Motors.

Former Mexican champ, Pedro Rodriguez, in a Ferrari Prototype No. 250 was third best qualifier, turning the 3.81 mile course at an average speed of 105.679 m.p.h.

The qualifying was marred by a serious accident involving James R. McCain of Atlanta. McCain's Chevrolet-powered Lister flipped in the backstretch and he was trapped in the wreckage.
