18 laps; 46.8 miles — Production Class C, D and E.

TEA PARTY TROPHY RACE

20 laps; 52 miles — Modified Cars Class B, C, D, and E.

GLOUCESTERMAN'S TROPHY RACE

15 laps; 39 miles — Production Cars Class F and G.

CLIPPERSHIP TROPHY RACE

30 laps; 78 miles — Production Cars Class D and E; Modified Cars Class F, G, and H.

BEVERLY TROPHY RACE

40 laps; 104 miles — Production Cars Class C; Modified Cars Class B, C, D, and E.

RACE CIRCUIT: 2.6 miles of macadam with one 4300 ft. straight and another 3800 ft.; Seven turns.
