'90 Chevrolet Corvette ZR1, #5801772. Red with tan interior, 56,000 miles, impeccably taken care of and looks like a nice new car. Despite the high miles, someone bought lots of fun when it **sold** at \$24,500.



'73 De Tomaso Pantera, #05592. Yellow over black interior, ugly late-model rubber bumpers, straight and remarkably free from the K-Mart add-ons that Pantera owners seem to fancy. Air cleaner painted yellow but otherwise a stock-looking car, it brought market price when it **sold** at \$18,700.

'47 Cisitalia Nuvolari Spider, chassis #002X, engine #029. The only example of 28 to be built with a steel body. Fiat-based 1100cc engine, very shiny red paint, tacky welding under the hood, aftermarket fuel pump, cracked glass over the speedometer. An interesting and attractive bit of motoring history that, despite more than enough bid, went strangely **unsold** at \$170,000.
