Trophy Awards:

1-2-3 awards in class. Three starters will constitute a sufficient field for each class. The Nassau trophy is a perpetual award and will be given in custody of the club of which the winner is a member. Arrangements for winner's possession may be made through the Club. BLACK



Stop at your pit.

YELLOW



Caution.

Yellow with Vertical Stripes



Caution

RED



The race has been stopped.

BLUE



You are being overtaken; give way.

WHITE



Caution. Ambulance or service car on course.

CHECKERED



You have finished the race.
