

## Castagna honoured with Belgian win

CORRADO LOPRESTO'S sensational Castagna-bodied 1931 Isotta Fraschini 8ASS Torpedo Sport was Best of Show at Spaltalia, Belgium's annual celebration of Latin classics. Castagna was the honoured coachbuilder for this year's festival at Spa-Francorchamps on 13-14 June, and other delectable beauties included Benetto Simi de Burgis' 1935 Fiat 508 Balilla. The triumph echoed Lopresto's victory last year with his 1949 Alfa Romeo 6C-2500 SS.

Elsewhere, Jean Detienne took top honours in the 'Nicest Bodywork for a Berline' class. It marked the third year on the trot that the prize has been taken by a Ferrariengined Lancia Thema 8.32.

Ferraris, Fiats and Alfas were prevalent among the 1300 cars at the eighth running of the staticshow-cum-track-day, which drew some 6000 visitors to Spa. Standouts included everything from a Fiat
